Auditors Report: The board received audit reports from Schneider Downs for the SSP, SACP and The Pittsburgh Conference. The auditors found no major deficiencies, but there were some issues with the Societies Treasurers properly reconciling their respected checkbooks in Quicken. The Auditors thought Quick Books may serve the purpose more efficient. Also, on-line banking may improve the reconciling processes.

Site Selection Committee Report: Dick Howe reported to the board that the site selection committee suggested that the board consider Philadelphia for the years 2026 and 2029. The cost of the hall will be \$186,000. The site selection committee suggest that the board pass a motion to approve Philadelphia 2026 and 2029 contracts contingent to the proposed edits for the first reading. A motion was made by Greg Melsner second Eli Absey the board voted unanimously. The second reading conference call will be next Wednesday February 22, 2017. Atlanta in 2022 has been a site that has been in question. Boston is willing to move some dates if we want to move forward. This is a "what if" situation for the feasibility of Boston availability and Atlanta to de-commit.
