

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MONDAY THROUGH WEDNESDAY POSTER PRESENTERS

How to Increase Attendance at Your Session

- Notify your contacts about your session at Pittcon 2022 via email, website post, or on social media.
- Create a flyer for your session to post or circulate at your institution.
- Your session will be listed on the Pittcon 2022 Mobile App. Remind your contacts to add your session to their Pittcon Agenda.
- Ask your contacts to invite *their* contacts to see your presentation.

General Information

If you need to withdraw your poster abstract, you must email program@pittcon.org. Failure to notify us will result in your name being added to a list of “no show” authors. These authors are banned from presenting at the Pittcon for 2 years. Only the first author on the abstract can make the withdrawal request.

Monday – Wednesday posters will be on the exposition floor, aisle 600.

PLEASE NOTE: You cannot get on the expo floor until 9:00 AM.

All Monday and Tuesday posters (morning and afternoon) are to be mounted by 10:00 AM and remain on display until 4:00 PM.

Wednesday posters are to be mounted by 9:00 AM and remain on display until 3:00 PM. (The Expo floor closes at 3:00 on Wednesday).

Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday Morning posters - You are to be present at your poster(s) from 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM.

Monday and Tuesday Afternoon posters - You are to be present at your poster(s) from 2:00 PM – 4:00 PM.

Wednesday Afternoon posters – You are to be present at your poster(s) 12:30 PM – 2:30 PM.

The Technical Program Committee will dispose of any posters that have not been taken down 30 minutes after the designated display time (by 4:30 PM on Monday and Tuesday; by 3:30 on Wednesday).

You must be at your poster the entire designated time – if your poster is on display and you are there to represent it, the poster will be removed and you will be noted as a “no show” author. These authors are banned from presenting at Pittcon for 2 years. We must be notified if there is an author change by sending an email to program@pittcon.org. The presenting author is the only person who can make requests for author changes or withdrawals.
